## Speeds are reduced on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City for road work

Construction work is currently underway on ND Highway 23 from six miles east of Watford City to the intersection of ND Highway 73 and ND Highway 23 (Johnson's Corner). Traffic speeds are reduced to 25 mph and 40 mph at times in various project areas to allow crews to work on the construction project.

Speeds will continue to be reduced until the project is completed in October.
