Truck traffic to cross at intersection of US Highway 2/85 and Energy Street north of Williston starting April 30

Beginning Thursday, April 30, heavy equipment traffic will be crossing at the intersection of US Highway 2/85 and Energy Street north of Williston during the day and evening hours from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Heavy equipment will be crossing the highway at this intersection and will travel north on US Highway 2/85 for approximately one mile until reaching the temporary truck reliever route. The equipment will then travel west on the temporary truck reliever route for approximately four miles before returning to Energy Street. This work is part of the Northwest Williston Truck Reliever Route.

During construction:

- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks exiting and entering this roadway

Construction equipment will be entering and exiting on US Highway 2/85 through early May.
