## Speeds reduced in some areas on US Highway 2 from Stanley to Berthold

Speeds are currently reduced in some areas on the eastbound lanes of US Highway 2, from Stanley to nine miles east of Berthold, and on the westbound lanes of US Highway 2, from one mile east of Berthold to three miles west of Berthold near (Brooks Junction). Traffic speeds are reduced to 40 mph and 60 mph at times in various project areas to allow crews to work on shoulder widening, turn lane construction, turn lane extensions and paving.

### During construction:

- Lane closures and reduced speeds will be present throughout the duration of the project at various locations
- Traffic Speeds reduced in some areas
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane at various times and locations
- A 16-foot width restriction will be in place
- Flaggers will be in place to assist with traffic control

This project is expected to be completed in October.
