Load restriction changes in northeastern North Dakota

Effective 7 a.m. CT, Tuesday, May 12, load restrictions will be lifted for majority of highways in northeastern North Dakota. The highways include highways east of and including a section of US Hwy 281, south of and including US Hwy 2 in the northeast region of North Dakota. Another restriction being lifted includes a section of ND Hwy 5 east of Langdon in Pembina County.

Motorists are encouraged to check the load restriction map daily as restrictions may change quickly due to weather.
