Load restriction changes in northwestern North Dakota

Effective 7 a.m. CT, Thursday, May 21, load restrictions will be implemented on some highways in northwestern North Dakota. The highways include Hwy 40 and Hwy 42 from Hwy 5 north to the Canadian Border, Hwy 50 from the junction of Hwy 42 west to the Montana Border and Hwy 1806 from the junction of Hwy 23 north to 2 miles east of Charlson.

Motorists are encouraged to check the load restriction map daily as restrictions may change quickly due to weather.
