US Highway 2 at 18th Street in Williston to reopen to four lanes of traffic over the Memorial weekend

Beginning today, Friday, May 22, US Highway 2 in Williston will reopen to four lanes of traffic from 9th Avenue Northwest to Box Elder Street. Lane closures will resume on Tuesday, May 26, and will take place intermittently to allow crews to continue paving and pavement marking work.

The NDDOT asks motorists to please slow down and obey the speed limit signs to keep motorists and work crews safe during this project.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced through the work area
- Flagger may be present
- Motorists may experience minimum delays

As the project progresses traffic control through the area will change. The project is expected to be complete in June.

The 18th Street project relieves congestion in the City of Williston by providing an overpass for US 2 traffic and an underpass for local 18th Street traffic in Williston. Pedestrian improvements include sidewalks, landscaping and lighting on either side of 18th Street as part of the underpass construction. For more information please go to www.nddotwilliston.com.
