Public Input Meeting to be held on June 18, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Hwy 42 from the junction of ND 50 to the junction of ND 5 and ND Hwy 5 from the junction of ND 42 to Noonan

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. on Thursday, June 18, 2015, at the Divide County Courthouse. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND 42 from the junction of ND 50 north to the junction of ND 5 and proposed improvements for ND 5 from the junction of ND 42 east to Noonan. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
