## **Speeds reduced on ND 200 from the Montana border northeast of Fairview to east of the Yellowstone Bridge**

Speeds are currently reduced to 45 mph in some areas for approximately 4 miles on ND Highway 200 beginning northeast of Fairview at the Montana border and ending approximately 1 mile east of the Yellowstone Bridge. Speeds are further reduced to 25 mph for approximately one mile near 160th Avenue northeast of Fairview to allow crews to perform box culvert extension work. No work is currently being performed east of this zone to beyond the Yellowstone Bridge. This project consists of a roundabout at the intersection of the ND Highway 200 and ND Highway 58 with new lighting at the roundabout, full road reconstruction from the Montana border to approximately 3 miles east, and pavement overlay east to the project's end, excluding the Yellowstone Bridge.

During construction:

- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks entering and exiting the area

This project is expected to be complete in October.
