## **Public Input Meeting to be held on July 7, to discuss proposed improvements to I-94 Exit 61 and ND Highway 22 in Dickinson**

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. (MDT) on Tuesday, July 7, 2015, at Dickinson City Hall, 99 2nd Street East, Dickinson, ND. The meeting will utilize an open house.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to I-94, Exit 61 and ND Highway 22. The project consists of adding right turn lanes along Highway 22 for the Exit 61 interchange, 12th Street, 14th Street, 15th Street, and striping improvements to the side streets. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Transportation will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.
