Construction begins Monday, July 6, on South State Avenue Bridge in Dickinson

Beginning on Monday, July 6, construction will begin on the South State Avenue Bridge in Dickinson. Construction will also take place on adjacent streets to provide access to the new S. State Avenue Bridge. Once complete, the bridge project will allow traffic to cross over railroad tracks. Roads that will be under construction near the bridge site include: S. State Avenue, 11th Ave SW, Palm Beach Road and W. Villard Street. The project will consist of Bridge Construction, Grading, Concrete and Asphalt Paving, Underground Utilities, Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter, Signing and Traffic Lighting and Signals.

During Construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- Flaggers will be in place at times
- Loose gravel may be present on roadways
- Motorists may experience minor delays

This project is expected to be complete in late fall of 2016.
