NDDOT seeks comments on 2015 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2015-2018 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of previously-unpublished projects in 2015 and for a change in the cost and scope of a previously-published project in 2015.

1. Administration of the Scenic Byway Program for years 2015 through 2017.
Total Cost: \$159,000
2. Widening was added to the project on ND Highway 46 from 9 miles east of Enderlin to the east junction of ND Highway 18 which increased the total cost for the project approximately \$5 million.
