## **12-foot width restriction in place on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City beginning today, July 27**

Beginning today, Monday, July 27, the width restriction on ND Highway 23 from north of the junction of ND Highway 73 (Johnson's Corner) east of Watford City to County Road 10 will be reduced from 14 feet to 12 feet to allow crews to perform shoulder widening work. This work is part of a widening and paving project on ND Highway 23 from the junction of ND Highway 73 (Johnson's Corner) north to near the junction of ND Highway 22.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced in some areas
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks and equipment exiting and entering the roadway
