Westbound Grant Marsh Bridge temporarily reduced to one lane Thursday, July 30 for routine bridge inspection

The westbound Grant Marsh Bridge on I-94 between Bismarck and Mandan will be temporarily reduced to one lane of traffic on Thursday, July 30 from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. (weather dependent) for a routine bridge inspection. This is part of the NDDOT's regular bridge inspection program conducted on all bridges across the state. During inspection work, traffic speeds will be reduced to 40 mph and a 14 foot width restriction will be in place. Motorists are urged to use caution and take alternate routes if possible during this time period.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
