Lane shifts to take place on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City throughout the construction season

Lane shifts will be in effect at various times on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City throughout the construction season as part of a paving and widening project. The road work is taking place on approximately 20 miles of highway from the ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 73 intersection (Johnson's Corner) to near the junction of ND Highway 22. Motorists should use caution when traveling through the area and should follow all posted signage.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced in some areas
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks and equipment exiting and entering the roadway

Various traffic restrictions will be in place on this portion of ND Highway 23 throughout the construction season.
