ND Highway 23 lane closure east of Watford City to begin today, August 19

Beginning today, Wednesday, August 19, ND Highway 23 east of Watford City from one mile east of the junction of ND Highway 1806 to the 116th Ave NW intersection will be reduced to one lane in some areas not to exceed three mile increments to allow crews to perform paving work. Motorists should use caution when traveling through the area and should obey all posted signage.

During construction:

- A pilot car will direct traffic through the construction zone
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flagger will be in place
- Speeds will be reduced

The pilot car and single lane traffic will be in place for two to three days at a time within a two-week span. Various traffic restrictions will be in place on this portion of ND Highway 23 throughout the construction season.

NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
