Maintenance work begins on Interstate 29 from Drayton to Canadian Border

Beginning on Monday, August 31, crews will begin maintenance work on Interstate 29 northbound and southbound lanes from Drayton to Canadian Border. Northbound lane closures will be in place from one mile north of Bowsemont Interchange to the Canadian Border. Southbound lane closures will be in place from Junction 66 near Drayton to the Canadian Border.

During Construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 65 mph in the lane closure and down to 40 mph near workers and equipment
- A 15-foot width restriction will be in place
- Single lane closures within work zones
- Flaggers will be present to guide traffic
- Oil will be present on the roadway
- Motorists may experience minor delays

This project will improve safety features on the roadway and is expected to be complete by the end of September.
