A portion of 67th Street near ND 40 in Tioga to be closed starting today, Monday, August 31, for realignment work

Beginning today, Monday, August 31, 67th Street NW near the junction of the ND Highway 40 intersection in Tioga will be closed for work on a road construction project. The approximately one-mile closure will extend from near the ND Highway 40 intersection to the 105th Ave NW intersection to allow crews to realign 67th Street NW and perform pipe installation. This is part of the ND Highway 40 construction project which consists of widening the existing two lane asphalt section to a three lane concrete section with eight-foot shoulders and turn lanes as well as adding traffic signals and street lighting.

During construction:

- Traffic will be detoured
- Motorists should follow all posted signage
- Motorists may experience delays

The detour will be in place for approximately two weeks.

NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
