## Final portion of the Williston Northwest Truck Reliever Route now open to two lanes

The final portion of the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route from 140<sup>th</sup> Ave NW to the US Highway 2 intersection near Love's Travel Stop is now open to two lanes of traffic. Traffic at this time will be head-to-head. The Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route is open to four lanes from the intersection of US Highway 2/85 north to the junction of 140<sup>th</sup> Ave NW.

During construction:

- Flaggers will be in place at times
- Speeds are reduced to 25 mph
- Motorists should expect delays

The remaining two lanes of this portion of the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route are scheduled to open later this fall.

The NDDOT Williston District serves the transportation needs of the communities in northwestern North Dakota, including Williston, Alexander, Watford City, New Town, Stanley, and Berthold. NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
