Lewis and Clark Bridge south of Williston temporarily closed for maintenance work on Tuesday, September 22

The Lewis and Clark Bridge on US Highway 85 south of Williston will be temporarily closed beginning at 7:30 a.m. on Tuesday, September 22, for maintenance work. Crews will be working throughout the day and evening as the bridge is expected to reopen at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 23.

Motorists will need to take alternate routes.

Suggested alternative routes crossing the Missouri River in North Dakota include:

- Four Bears Bridge on ND 23 near New Town
- Yellowstone Bridge near Fairview on ND 200
- Mon/Dak Bridge near Buford on ND 58
