Pilot car to guide traffic on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City on Saturday, September 12, and Monday, September 14

Tomorrow, Saturday, September 12, and Monday, September 14, a pilot car will be guiding traffic on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City from the 112th Ave NW intersection to the 116th Ave NW intersection to allow crews to continue paving work. Motorists will take turns traveling through the area.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays.
- Speeds are reduced to 25 mph
- A 12-foot width restriction is in place
