## **Westbound traffic shifted to adjacent roadway near ND 200 east of Fairview beginning Saturday, September 12**

Beginning tomorrow, Saturday, September 12, westbound traffic will be shifted to a newly-created gravel roadway adjacent to ND Highway 200 from near the Yellowstone Bridge to near the ND Highway 58/200 intersection to allow crews to perform paving work. Eastbound traffic will travel on the widened gravel shoulder of the existing road. This work is part of a project which consists of a roundabout at the intersection of the ND Highway 200 and ND Highway 58 with new lighting at the roundabout, full road reconstruction from the Montana border to approximately 3 miles east, and pavement overlay east to the project's end, excluding the Yellowstone Bridge.

During construction:

- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place from the Montana border to County Road 1 near Cartwright
- Speeds are currently reduced to 25 mph from near the ND Highway 58/200 intersection to the Yellowstone Bridge
- Speeds are currently reduced to 20 mph on the temporary roadways at the ND Highway 58/200 intersection
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists should be prepared to stop

The gravel roadways will be in place through October.

NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
