Various lane closures may be in place at US 2/Williston Northwest Truck Reliever Route intersection starting tomorrow

Beginning tomorrow, Thursday, September 24, various lane closures may be in place at the intersection of US Highway 2 and the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route near Love's Travel Stop to allow crews to perform permanent pavement marking work and install new traffic signals. This work is part of the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route.

During construction:

- Speeds are reduced to 25 mph

The permanent striping and signal work is expected to be complete in approximately two weeks.

The NDDOT Williston District serves the transportation needs of the communities in northwestern North Dakota, including Williston, Alexander, Watford City, New Town, Stanley, and Berthold. NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
