Portion of 2nd Street and 67th Street near ND 40 in Tioga to be temporarily closed starting tomorrow

Beginning Tuesday, October 13, 2nd Street NE and 67th Street NW near the junction of the ND Highway 40 intersection in Tioga will be temporarily closed for paving work. This is part of the ND Highway 40 construction project which consists of widening the existing two lane asphalt section to a three lane concrete section with eight-foot shoulders and turn lanes as well as adding traffic signals and street lighting.

During construction:

- 2nd Street NE and 67th Street NW traffic will be detoured to Williams County Road 21/105th Avenue NW and then to the intersection of 66th Street NW and ND Highway 40
- Motorists should follow all posted signage
- Motorists may experience delays

The detour will be in place through Friday, October 16.
