## **Four Bears Bridge near New Town to be temporarily reduced to one lane beginning on Monday, October 19**

Beginning on Monday, October 19, traffic will be temporarily reduced to one lane during the daylight hours on the Four Bears Bridge on ND Highway 23 near New Town to allow crews to perform inspection work. Motorists will have to take turns crossing the bridge.

During inspection:

- Flagger will be stationed at each end of the bridge
- Motorists should expect short delays

The closure is expected to be in place through Thursday, October 22.
