66th Street near ND 40 in Tioga temporarily closed starting today; 67th Street open

Beginning today, 67th Street NW near the junction of the ND Highway 40 intersection in Tioga is now open. The street was temporarily closed for paving work. However, 66th Street NW west of the junction of the ND Highway 40 intersection in Tioga is temporarily closed for approximately two weeks. 2nd Street NE west of the junction of ND Highway 40 will also remain closed for approximately one week. This is part of the ND Highway 40 construction project which consists of widening the roadway and shoulders, adding turn lanes, traffic signals and street lighting.

During construction:

- 2nd Street NE and 66th Street NW traffic will be temporarily detoured to Williams County Road 21/105th Avenue NW and then to the intersection of 67th Street NW and ND Highway 40
- Motorists should follow all posted signage
- Motorists may experience delays

NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
