Public Input Meeting to be held on December 10, 2015, to discuss Proposed Improvements to Interstate 94 through Bismarck from the Grant Marsh Bridge to East Bismarck Interchange.

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 pm on Thursday, December 10, 2015, at the Courtyard by Marriott - Bismarck North location, in the Clark Room. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for Interstate 94 from the Grant Marsh Bridge to East Bismarck Interchange through Bismarck. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
