US Hwy 83 between Lake Sakakawea and Snake Creek south of Garrison open to 4-lane traffic

The Corps of Engineers has completed work on a project located on US 83 at the Snake Creek Embankment south of Garrison and opened it to 4-lane traffic. During the project the northbound and southbound lanes were temporarily closed while the Corps completed work on gate well covers. Motorists should be aware there is still a temporary 45 mph speed limit in place through this area and they will also encounter a temporary bump due to a thick steel plate on the roadway. This plate will remain on the roadway until work resumes next summer.
