Public Input Meeting on January 28, to discuss proposed improvements to US Highway 2 from 32nd Ave to 11th St in Williston

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on January 28, 2016 at the Wilkinson Elementary School, 1200 9th Ave NW, in Williston, North Dakota. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 6:45 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss reconstruction of portions of US Highway 2 between 32nd Avenue and 11th Street in Williston. The discussion will also include evaluation of intersection options for the 2nd Street and 32nd Avenue area. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT, the City of Williston and Civil Science, Inc. will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
