North Dakota residents reminded to update address on driver's license upon moving

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is reminding residents of North Dakota to update your address on your North Dakota driver's license or identification card within 10 days of moving to a new residential location.

State law requires you to notify the NDDOT within ten days of changing residential addresses. Noncommercial drivers may notify the department by phone at 701-328-2600, online at <https://apps.nd.gov/dot/dlts/dlos/addressWelcome.htm> or at any drivers license office. While you are not legally required to have the updated address on the card, we do encourage the purchase of a new license due to identification purposes. The fee for an address change and printing of new identification is \$3. Commercial (CDL) drivers are legally required to have the updated address on the card.
