Construction begins June 27 on Interstate 29 near Drayton

Construction begins Monday, June 27, on the northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate 29 near Drayton. Work will consist of mill and overlay to provide a smoother ride for the traveling public.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced through work area
- A width restriction will be in place, but may change frequently so please check the travel information map for up-to-date restrictions
- Flaggers will be present
- Oil may be on the roadway
- Motorists may experience minimal delays

The project is expected to be complete by the end of July, weather permitting.
