Public Input Meeting to be held on July 14, 2016, to discuss Proposed Improvements to ND Highway 5 near Mohall

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 pm on July 14, 2016, at the Mohall City Hall (City Council Room), 203 Main Street East, Mohall, ND. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to ND 5 from the west junction of ND 28 to Mohall. These improvements include sliver widening and a hot bituminous pavement overlay. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT will be available to answer questions.
