Public Input Meeting to be held on September 22 to discuss Intersection Improvements to US Highway 2/42nd Street SE in Minot, North Dakota

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, September 22, 2016, at the Minot Municipal Auditorium, Room 201, 423 3rd Avenue SW, Minot. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:15 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to the US Highway 2 and 42nd Street SE intersection in Minot, ND from Reference Point 149.70 to Reference Point 150.25. The project consists of reconstructing the existing intersection of US Highway 2, 42nd Street SE and 14th Avenue SE to provide increased frontage road separation, turn lanes, pedestrian crossing, traffic signal and intersection lighting. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. The open house will be conducted by the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and SRF Consulting Group, Inc.
