


Bridge Program Update





WHERE DO BRIDGE FUNDS COME FROM?

Bridge Federal Formula Program (BFP) = \$45M per year ('22-'26) **Bridge Investment Program (BIP) or Competitive Bridge Grants**

- Three Award Categories
 - Planning Level Projects
 - Bridge Projects <=\$100M (Min Grant Award of \$2.5M)
 - Bridge Projects >\$100M (Min Grant Award of \$50M)

STBG = \$3.19M (fed-aid routes)

Other Discretionary Grants (AID, RAISE, INFRA, PROTECT, NHPP, CMAQ, RSTG, etc.)

Prairie Dog Funds=\$160M Available (100% Local)

ND Flexible Transportation Funds=\$224.5M Available (21% State & Local, 79% Local)

BRIDGE FEDERAL FORMULA PROGRAM

County System

- 15% of BFP minimum set aside for County off-system = \$6.75M
- Additional BFP for County System = \$17.66M (DOT Discretionary)
- STBG for County System = \$3.19M

County System Subtotal = **\$27.6M**

State System

- BFP for the State System = \$20.59M (Stand-Alone NBI, including Urban)
- Additional Rural OA = \$7.5M (Corridor-NBI/Non-NBI & Stand-Alone Non-NBI)

State System Subtotal = **\$28.1M**

Total Federal Formula Funds for ND bridges = \$55.7M * *Excludes Discretionary Funds

TOTAL ANTICIPATED BRIDGE FUNDING FOR '26

County System ~ \$53M*

- 15% of BFP minimum set aside for County off-system = \$6.75M
- Additional BFP for County System = \$17.66M (DOT Discretionary)
- STBG for County System = \$3.19M
- Local Match = \$5.52M
- Flex Funds = \$20.13M
- Prairie Dog Funds = Unknown at this point


State System~ \$35M*

- BFP for the State System = \$20.59M (Stand-Alone NBI, including Urban)
- Additional Rural OA = \$7.50M (Corridor-NBI/Non-NBI & Stand-Alone Non-NBI)
- State & Local Match = \$7.0M

Total Funding for ND bridges = \$88M *
*Excludes Federal Discretionary Funds & Prairie Dog Funds

BRIDGE INVESTMENT PROGRAM GRANTS

- Bridge Investment Program (BIP)
 ND 1806 Bridge Replacements
 (Awarded Oct. 2024) This project will
 replace two deteriorated State
 System bridges and provide
 bicycle/pedestrian facilities in
 support of the Standing Rock WOZU
 development. \$9.4M
- BIP Valley City Viking Bridge Replacement (Awarded Oct. 2024).
 \$2.7M



OTHER COMPETITIVE GRANTS

RAISE Grant – Marley Crossing Planning (Awarded Jan. 2025) This project will develop the environmental and preliminary-design documents necessary to apply for a construction grant to install a rail-highway grade separation on ND 1804 south of Trenton near recent industrial developments.
