WORK DRAWINGS

From the Standard Specifications:

Work Drawings. Supplemental design sheets or similar data, such as drawings, diagrams, illustrations, samples, schedules, or calculations, that the contract requires the Contractor to submit to the Engineer in accordance with Section 105.08, "Work Drawings." Once the Department has reviewed a work drawing, it becomes part of the contract.

How do I know if Work Drawings are required?

- Standard Specifications
- Plan Notes
- Special Provisions
- Other Contract Documents

 - Guidance for Processing Work Drawings
- The Work Drawings will be exchanged on the NDDOT Managed File Transfer (MFT) site.
- Correspondence will take place via email or other means.
- Distribute the work drawings with no exceptions as necessary.
