<b>Eligible Project Types</b>	FTA will evaluate proposals based on the criteria listed in Section E of the NOFO		
<b>Program Description</b>	The FTA ADCMS Program goal is to: “promote, implement, deploy, demonstrate, showcase, support, and document” advanced digital construction management systems. One of the US Department of Transportation’s major initiatives is to increase infrastructure project excellence. Accelerating the use of digital tools across the lifecycle of an infrastructure program can result in significant benefits to transit agencies, especially to reduce cost overruns and mitigate potential schedule changes.		
<b>Eligible Activities</b>	The Program Lead must provide for at least two transit agencies to demonstrate at least two different ADCMS solutions, and the construction projects used for demonstrations must be FTA-funded projects. Accordingly, the Program Lead must have the capability to support the implementation of more than one ADCMS-integrated software solution.		
<b>Minimum Award</b>	This Notice makes available \$5,093,000 to award one Program Lead.		
<b>Additional Information</b>	Federal Share shall be 80%.
