Program Description	The vision of the PROTECT Discretionary Grant Program is to fund projects that address the climate crisis by improving the resilience of the surface transportation system, including highways, public transportation, ports, and intercity passenger rail. Projects selected under this program should be grounded in the best available scientific understanding of climate change risks, impacts, and vulnerabilities. \$848M available.		
Eligible Projects	Described in detail on pages 15-19 of NOFO. Planning Grants: Resilience planning, evacuation planning, and development of resilience plan. Resilience Grants: Construction activities to create more resilient infrastructure.		
Eligible Costs	Described in detail on pages 22-23 of NOFO. Development phase activities are eligible for both planning and resilience grants, construction activities are eligible for resilience grants.		
Additional Information	Federal Share must not exceed 80% for resilience grants. Planning grants may have up to 100% federal share. Min Planning Grant award size \$100K, No Max. Min Resilience Grant award size \$500K, No Max.
