

FY24-26 Nationally Significant Federal Lands and Tribal Projects Program

Program Description – Grants under the NSFLTP Program are to be awarded on a competitive basis to projects of national significance for construction, reconstruction, or rehabilitation of transportation facilities within, adjacent to, or providing access to Federal or Tribal Lands.

Eligible Projects – Construction, reconstruction, or rehabilitation of a single continuous project on a Federal Lands transportation facility, a Federal Lands access transportation facility, or a Tribal transportation facility, for which activities required under NEPA are complete and which has an estimated total project cost equal to or exceeding \$12,500,000.

Period of Performance (pg. 9) - Begin on the date the NSFLTP Program funds are obligated in FMIS and end on the project end date in FMIS.

Eligible Project Costs (pg. 12) - A project receiving NSFLTP Program funds may use the funds only for construction, reconstruction, or rehabilitation of transportation facilities. Project design activities, including preliminary engineering, are not eligible for NSFLTP Program funds or allowable toward match requirements.

Application & Narrative Requirements (pages 13-26) – The application must include the following: Standard Forms (SF-424); SF-424C & SF-424D; Grants.gov Lobbying Form; SF-LLL, Cover Page with chart included from page 14 of NOFO; completed NEPA document; and Project Narrative.
