Additional Applicant Eligibility Requirements: Applicants must have sufficient legal, financial, and technical capabilities. Except for projects proposed by Indian tribes, all projects in rural areas* must be submitted by a State either individually or as part of a consolidated State application. States and other eligible applicants may also submit consolidated applications for projects in urbanized areas. The same project may not be submitted in multiple applications.

* (The term "rural area" means an area encompassing a population of less than 50,000 people that has not been designated in the most recent decennial census as an "urbanized area" by the Secretary of Commerce.)

Eligible Project Costs:

Purchasing, leasing, or rehabilitating buses regardless of propulsion type or emissions. Purchasing, leasing, rehabilitating, or constructing bus-related facilities and equipment, regardless of propulsion type or emissions.

Application Contents and Format:

A complete proposal submission consists of two forms and any supporting attachments: SF-424, Supplemental Form.
