

## Defense Community Infrastructure Pilot Program Grant

<b>Proposal Deadline</b> June 23, 2025	<b>Formal Grant Invite Around</b> Aug. 8, 2025	<b>Award/Obligation Deadline</b> Sept. 30, 2025	<b>Expenditure Deadline</b> 5 years from date of award
<b>Eligible Applicants</b>	State or local government, not-for-profit, member-owned utility services.		
<b>Program Description</b>	Funds to assist State and local governments to address deficiencies in community infrastructure supportive of a military installation. Community infrastructure projects are transportation projects, community support facilities, and utility infrastructure projects that are located off of a military installation or on property under the jurisdiction of a Secretary of a military department that is subject to a real estate agreement, and are owned by a State or local government or a not-for-profit, member owned utility service.		
<b>Unique Program Items</b>	Complete and eligible proposals from eligible entities will be evaluated against specific criteria, successful proposals will be invited to submit a formal grant application.		
<b>Eligible Projects</b> (Pg 7)	All proposed projects must be construction-ready and must result in a complete and useable project.		
<b>Eligible Costs</b> (Pg 8-9)	Only hard construction and renovation costs, such as the costs directly associated with project administration, inspection, construction, utilities, and contingency costs required to execute the project, as well as costs of capital equipment affixed to the real property with a depreciable life of not less than seven (7) years.		
<b>Selection Criteria</b> (Pgs 20-22)	<p><b>Criteria 1</b> – Enhance Military Value (50 Points)*</p> <p><b>Criteria 2</b> – Community-Installation Need (20 points)</p> <p><b>Criteria 3</b> – Construction-Readiness (30 points):</p> <p>* Proposals that do not identify the military value prioritization category will need to meet three (3) of the four (4) military value criteria,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. That will enhance military value (40 - 45 points)</li> <li>2. That will contribute to the training of cadets (34 - 39 points)</li> <li>3. That will enhance military installation resilience (28 - 33 points)</li> <li>4. That will enhance military family quality of life (22 - 27 points)</li> </ol>
