Eligible Applicants	A unit of local government or political subdivision outside of an urbanized area with a	
	population of more than 150,000 residents; a state seeking to advance a project located	
	outside of an urbanized area with a population of more than 150,000; a federally recognized	
	Indian Tribe; or the Department of Hawaiian Homelands.	
Project Phases	Projects receiving assistance under this Program must be reasonably expected to be eligible for	
	any one or more of the USDOT's lending or grant program; TIFIA, RRIF, INFRA, RAISE, Mega,	
	and the National Culvert Removal, Replacement, and Restoration Grant Program.	
	The program provides grants to fund financial, technical, and legal assistance to states and	
Program	rural and tribal communities. The grants are intended to increase organizational capacity in	
Description	communities that may not have resources available to evaluate and develop projects that	
	qualify for federal funding and financing programs.	
Unique Program Items	First-come, first-served basis. The Bureau will provide an <u>on-line form</u> that can be completed	
	beginning 2 p.m. ET on August 14, 2023. The BIL limits awards to any individual state to 20% of	
	available funds for a single fiscal year.	
Eligible Projects	1) acquire the services of independent financial, technical, and legal advisors, or	
	2) hire staff, in each case to provide development-phase assistance.	
Eligible Costs	Eligible expenses are reimbursed from the Government monthly. Expenses incurred prior to	
	the grant agreement are not eligible.	
Additional Info.	Criteria's: Appropriateness of services requested. Viability of grant funds requested.
