I-94 INTERCHANGE (EXIT 161) RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

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We're in the thick of construction! This month, crews completed pouring the new concrete bridge deck and advancing work on the west side. As work progresses, expect varied traffic changes on I-94, Centennial Road/Bismarck Expressway, and surrounding streets.



The deck was placed in four separate pours, each requiring a seven-day cure. The final pour is curing and will be complete by mid-July. In total, the bridge will use roughly 500 truckloads of concrete, with the deck itself accounting for 125.



Once the concrete cures, crews will remove the wood forms and work on final bridge elements, including decorative columns, crash barriers, curbs, median islands, pedestrian fencing, and more.



TRAFFIC PATTERN ON CENTENNIAL ROAD/ BISMARCK EXPRESSWAY

North and southbound traffic is reduced to one lane from Trenton Drive to Miriam Avenue to accommodate pedestrian access on Centennial Road/Bismarck Expressway.



A temporary pedestrian walkway is in place from Trenton Drive to the I-94 West on-ramp and from Miriam Avenue to the I-94 East off-ramp. Pedestrians will follow the designated path, briefly return to the existing sidewalk across the bridge, then reconnect with the temporary walkway.

Additionally, Miram Avenue is closed to the west of Centennial Road/ Bismarck Expressway, with a detour provided via Divide Avenue. The closure will remain in place until necessary concrete work is completed.
