

FY25 NDDOT CONSTRUCTION PERIOD REVIEW

- 2024-2026 NDDOT Triennial Goal 4.25%
 - Goal updated March 2025 to Step 1 Figure of 3.48%
- FY25 DBE Commitments on NDDOT Federal Aid Construction Projects at Time of Award:
 - \$19.28M Committed to DBEs October 1, 2024 August 15, 2025 (last bid opening in FY25)
 - DBE Primes \$1.5M 7.55%
- DBE Manufacturers \$194k 1.01%

■ DBE Subs \$9M – 47.67%

- DBE Suppliers \$532k 2.76%
- DBE Trucking \$3.7M 19.27%
- DBE Distributors \$4.2M 21.74%



- Federal Register :: Disadvantaged Business Enterprise
 Program and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise in
 Airport Concessions Program Implementation
 Modifications instructions to submit comments by 11/3
- Removes race- and sex-based presumptions from definitions of "socially and economically disadvantaged individual," and instead provides that the owner of a DBE or ACDBE applicant must demonstrate on a case-by-case basis that the individual meets criteria listed in the IFR



- NDDOT is currently drafting a letter that will be sent to ND based firms with further information on the recertification process
- All UCPs must immediately begin to apply these new certification standards
- All UCPs must reevaluate all current DBEs and ACDBEs, recertify any DBE or ACDBE that meets the new certification standards, and decertify any DBE or ACDBE that does not meet the new certification standards



- Until a UCP completes the reevaluation process, each recipient covered by that UCP may not:
 - Include contract goals all goals/DBE SPs being removed from 10/10 bid opening
 - Count any participation toward overall DBE or ACDBE goals
- NDDOT is drafting a letter informing the industry of the IFR
- Utilization Plans will still be sent after project award –
 Prompt Pay requirements still apply
- DBE Directory may be disabled until updates completed



- NDDOT still waiting for guidance on:
 - How to address awarded projects prior to 10/3
 - If DBEs must be decertified prior to being recertified or if their certifications could just be suspended
 - Decertification could mean a full recertification process
 - Suspension could mean only the narrative would be required
- Bid Opening Documents/Processes not required until further notice
 - Includes Bidders List
 - Anything DBE RGN & RGC SP related
 - Prompt Pay SP still in effect
