OVERVIEW

The renewal courses are for anyone actively involved in the construction industry within the last five years with a certification due for renewal in 2024.

Renewal courses combine homework (viewing pre-recorded videos) and a live 3-hour Microsoft Teams Meeting for Q&A and additional updates.

The Aggregate Renewal and Asphalt Mix Renewal courses are combined in a single session. Content includes topics for Aggregate Gradations, Aggregate Field Lab Tester, Aggregate Designer and Asphalt Mix Tester, and Mix Controller. If you are an Asphalt Mix Controller who does not hold current tester certification this is the only requirement. *All tester certifications require a performance exam every five years*.

Performance exam registration is through the <u>NDDOTTCP website</u>

The Aggregate Renewal exam will be focused on aggregate tests.

The Asphalt Pavement Inspection Renewal course completes all requirements for renewal for Asphalt Pavement Inspectors.

Certification renewal does not update an expired certification.
