OVERVIEW

Asphalt Pavement Inspection is a course for individuals pursuing certification through TCP to work on QC/QA asphalt paving projects. Each course is approximately 24 hours including the online exam on the last day.

This course includes an overview of the asphalt paving process from material production to placement. Completion provides certification as an Asphalt Pavement Inspector which is required for both Contractor (QC) and Engineer (QA) personnel during mix production.

This course is open and encouraged for all construction professionals involved in asphalt pavement design, material production, and all asphalt paving.
