CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Milling has officially begun on Memorial Highway, and increased truck traffic and flaggers are now present throughout the area. Drivers are urged to stay alert and exercise extra caution when passing through the construction zone. On 40th Avenue SE, traffic has shifted to a temporary roadway to accommodate ongoing work. Meanwhile, 19th Street remains closed as crews continue utility and storm sewer improvements. Looking ahead, work on the lift station is expected to begin early May.



TRAFFIC SAFETY REMINDERS

- One lane in each direction with a center turn lane
- Speed limit reduced to 25 mph
- 11-foot width restriction
- 19th St SE remains closed
