NDDOT TECHNICAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM (TCP)

Performance Exam

Aggregate and asphalt testing performance exams are scheduled through the TCP Class Registration web page.

Exams for new students may be scheduled up to 12 months after completing a class. Exams are offered during the winter training season.

<u>This link</u> provides the tests and procedures available for certification.

EXPECTATIONS

Understand which certification you (your employer) are requesting

On-the-job training is expected before attempting a performance exam

Be prepared to begin at your scheduled time

Know the procedures

Bring a copy of the procedures. They are found in the current ND Field Sampling and Testing Manual.

Reference to a procedure is allowed.

You may not read from the procedure.

Two opportunities are given to demonstrate each test and procedure. The exam will be stopped if you are unable to demonstrate the tests and procedures

A repeat performance exam must then be scheduled for a later date.

This will be the final attempt to complete the exam and may NOT be completed on the same day. If the second exam is unsuccessful, the class must be repeated.

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION

You are graded on your ability to correctly and thoroughly verbally or physically describe or perform all major steps of each procedure.

This may include times, temperatures, calculations, rounding, and reporting accuracy
