Recent rains have slowed progress, however, we want to assure you that we're moving forward as quickly, and safely, as possible. Wet conditions require time for the ground to properly dry before crews can resume certain activities without compromising quality or safety.

As you travel through the work zone, please continue to drive with caution and for the conditions. Some areas of the roadway may be uneven or rougher than others, and you may need to reduce your speed, even below the posted limits, to navigate safely.

2025 Independence Day Parade

As a reminder, changes are being implemented for the staging and spectator viewing areas of the 2025 Mandan 4th of July Parade. Parade staging will now take place along West Memorial Highway from Third Street SE to Mandan Avenue, and as a result, there will be no public viewing along Memorial Highway this year. West Memorial Highway from Third St. SE to Mandan Ave will close at 6 a.m. on July 4 and remain closed until the parade concludes.

Access to nearby businesses will be maintained, but drivers are advised to plan ahead for increased congestion and delays when entering Mandan that morning. Alternate routes such as I-94 Exits 152 (Sunset Drive) and 153 (Mandan Avenue) are recommended.
