CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Crews have been making steady progress along the corridor. Utility work was recently completed on 40th Ave SE, and relocation of water and sanitary sewer lines continues on 19th Street, along with ongoing storm sewer installation to the north and south.

A temporary road is being built on 40th Ave SE, and an 11-foot width restriction is now in place along Memorial Highway to accommodate construction activities. Traffic patterns will continue to shift as crews work to complete traffic safety measures and relocate traffic signals. Concrete barriers are also being placed along Memorial Highway in preparation for full roadway removals, which are expected to begin shortly thereafter.



TRAFFIC SAFETY REMINDERS

- One lane in each direction with a center turn lane
- Speed limit reduced to 25 mph
- 11-foot width restriction
- 19th St NE remains closed

Please drive carefully—follow traffic control and obey posted speed limits to protect yourself and others.

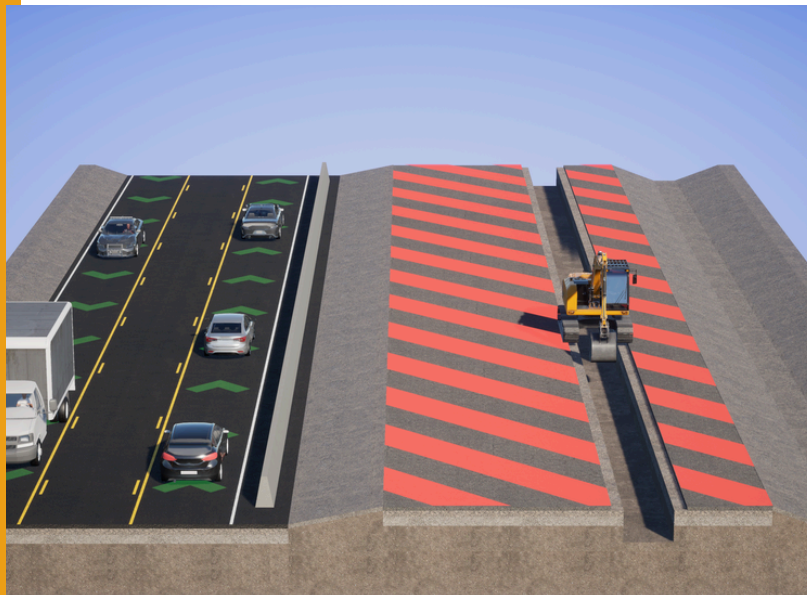
