### Traffic changes on 19th and 21st Streets Southeast

As of today, 19th Street Southeast is officially open, restoring a key east-west route in southeast Mandan!

Up next, 21st Street Southeast will temporarily close starting Thursday, May 15, between Shoal Loop Southeast and 46th Ave Southeast for storm sewer installation. Shoal Loop Southeast will stay open. This closure is expected to last about a month.

Drivers using the temporary roadway on 40th Ave Southeast, please continue to slow down, follow signage, and watch for flaggers and trucks.



### Heads Up in the Construction Zone

- One lane each direction with a center turn lane
- Speed limit is 25 mph—no exceptions
- Vehicles wider than 11ft? Plan ahead
- 21st Street Southeast closes May 15 from Shoal Loop Southeast to 46th Ave Southeast

Flaggers are working. Trucks are moving. Please drive like your family lives here.
